ARTIST STATEMENT

I simply love 'form'. I am attracted to 'form' beyond the boundaries of art, art and figurative objects. I am drawn to the unimaginable lines, the undulation of curved surfaces, and the well-balanced distortion of the form. The shapes that resonate with the viewer's subconscious and instincts are the creatures of the natural world, and the natural world has a design strength that transcends human knowledge. How much can I approach it, how many hints can I take from it, and how much can I borrow from it to express my own aesthetics in my sculptures? I think it is art to explain the meaning of your work in words and get sympathy from the viewer, but unfortunately I cannot see this as a good thing. I am moved only by a good 'form' that makes my brain leak pleasant substances just by looking at it, without the need for verbal explanations.

I would like to create a 'form' that melts the hearts of those who see it, just like 'devil', the meaning behind the word 'AMMON'.
