ARTIST STATEMENT

The white clay of Shigaraki-Iga melts at the high temperature and high heat of a wood-fired kiln called "Anagama" as if the clay and ash are interlocked, and the carbon dyes the base black or burns through to form a red fire color and a variety of kiln-changing scenery. "Clay and Anagama" What can happen with such a simple combination? Anagama has a secret. Every time I fire the kiln, it feels as if I am experimenting.

PROFILE

Nozomu SHINOHARA | Ceramic Artist

Born in Osaka in 1972. He is based in Shiga, the ceramic village of Shigaraki. After studying under Nobuo Furuya in 1991, he completed the glaze course at Shiga Prefectural Shigaraki Ceramic Technical Research Institute in 1998. Certified as a traditional craftsman of Shigaraki ware by the Minister of Economy, Trade and Industry; awarded the 23rd Shumei Cultural Foundation Award in 2012; participated in workshops and train kiln firing at Stanford University and Utah State University in 2019.
